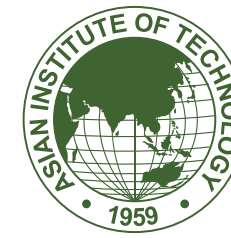

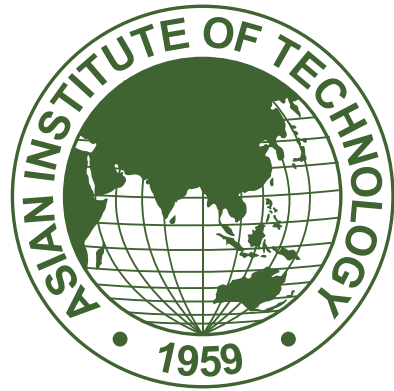

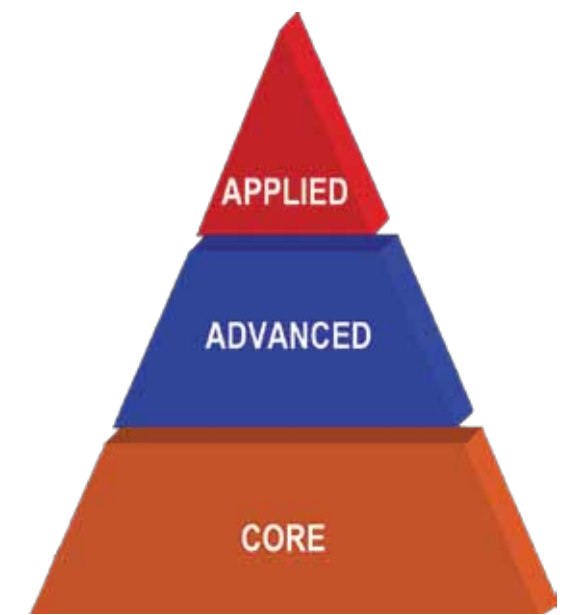
PROGRAM STRUCTURE

LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

- AIT English Entry Test (5.0)

ENGLISH TRAINING PROGRAM

AIT provides a 7-week intensive English Training for those required to increase their English and Academic skills before joining the program. This program includes tips on how to conduct AITEET.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for admission to the AIT Professional master's program, an applicant must:

- Hold a Bachelor degree (from a four-year program), or its equivalent, in a relevant field of study.
- Have above average undergraduate grades.
- Have good command of English
- At least three-year working experience.
